Cancer Exclusion Validation Report (eCW Model)

- Diagnosis codes for cancer or history of organ removal come from the Problem List
- The report now also displays patients who had any cancer or history of organ removal diagnosis code on an Assessment but not any on the Problem List (and no other evidence of exclusion)

Cancer Exclusion Validation Report (NextGen Model)

- In most cases, diagnosis codes for cancer or history of organ removal come from "patient diagnosis"
- The report now also displays patients who had any cancer or history of organ removal diagnosis code from "encounter diagnosis" or "problem list" but not any from "patient diagnosis" (and no other evidence of exclusion)

Using the Record-Level Validation Reports

- Good idea to make these lists in December so that staff can start working on them.
 Then, in January, run them again to get the most recent records to the end of 2020

Validation Reports Common Between eCW and NextGen

- Incomplete Labs
- Incomplete or Non-Standard
 Demographic Data
- Problem List
- Persistent Asthma Diagnosis
- Cancer Exclusions

Additional eCW Validation Reports

- Incomplete Images
- Unattached Labs and Images
- Incomplete OB Records

Patient-Level Lab Reports

Incomplete Labs (eCW and NextGen)

- See the section "Report Description" in the report instructions for a definition of what records appear on the report. Do these definitions follow your health center quidelines for completing lab records?
- Generally, these records have some, but not all fields, completed. Therefore, they may be "missed" by your lab transformers

Patient-Level Lab Reports

Incomplete Labs (eCW and NextGen)

- Displays only QM-related labs
- The column "Main issue" indicates what may be wrong with the lab record
- In most cases, the lab record can be completed by adding the missing information

Patient-Level Image Reports (eCW only)

Incomplete Image Validation Report (eCW)

- Uses a similar approach as the incomplete lab report because the data is structured similarly in eCW
- Displays only QM-related images
- The column "Main issue" indicates what may be wrong with the image record
- In most cases, the image record can be completed by adding the missing information

Patient-Level Lab/Image Reports (eCW only)

<u>Unattached Lab and Image Validation</u> <u>Report (eCW)</u>

- There may be lab or image documents scanned or entered into eCW but not placed in the appropriate folder or attached to the appropriate order
- Displays records for patients not already in the QM numerator.
- Suggests records for further investigation.
 See "Action needed" column for details.

Patient-Level Demographic Report

Demographics Validation Report (eCW and NextGen)

- May need further customization/set-up depending on unique data entry patterns. The default version of the report looks at many things, including data manipulation by Transformers which is more of a setup issue than a record-level issue.
- Therefore, you can create a custom version that shows only the records you know need to be changed (eg, bad zip codes, non-standard races, etc.)
- Column "Action needed agg" displays suggestions for what may be wrong with the record (aggregated, because there may be more than one problem)

Problem List Validation Report (eCW and NextGen)

- Follows the model originally developed for eCW: the Problem List is the source of truth for chronic disease diagnoses
- Five main QM chronic diseases (DM, HTN, depression, IVD and ASCVD)
- Requires provider time to correct the record (so make sure report is valid)

Problem List Validation Report (eCW and NextGen)

- Displays patients with a chronic disease diagnosis code on an assessment or claim but no diagnosis code for the same chronic disease on the Problem List
- Displays patients with a chronic disease diagnosis code on the Problem List but never a diagnosis code for the same chronic disease on an assessment or claim
- Column "Record summary" displays the combination of codes present or missing from the sources
- Column "Check action" suggests how to approach further investigation into the record

Problem List Validation Report (NOTE for NextGen)

- NextGen health centers might not follow the same model. However, the report was reproduced for them in case they adopt the model.
- Good idea to check the Transformers to see where diagnosis codes are being picked-up (i.e., patient diagnosis versus encounter diagnosis versus problem list)
- The NextGen validation report "Diagnosis Location Report" can be filtered to display the number of unduplicated patients identified from each source, by chronic disease

Persistent Asthma Diagnosis Validation Report (eCW and NextGen)

- Similar to the Problem List Validation Report but focuses on asthma
- Also considers if a patient is taking medications for persistent asthma and if the patient has diagnosis codes for both persistent and intermittent asthma on the Problem List
- Column "Check action" suggests what to investigate further

Cancer Exclusion Validation Report (eCW and NextGen)

- Displays patients with incomplete exclusion text from Surgical History
- eCW: Displays patients with a cancer exclusion diagnosis code on an Assessment but not in the Problem List
- NextGen: Displays patients with a cancer exclusion diagnosis code on the Problem List or encounter diagnosis, but not patient diagnosis

Patient-Level OB Report (eCW)

Incomplete OB Records (eCW)

- Default report needs to be customized (see instructions)
- Lists all OB patients. Once exported to Excel, the column "Action needed" can be used to filter for patients with particular kinds of missing or erroneous data
- If the OB record is still "open" then the required data can be entered into it.
 Otherwise, enter the data into your Excel spreadsheet and summarize it from there for the UDS report
