Goals and Initial Objectives:	 i. Improve data quality Proactively identify data quality issues before they become visible and costly. Help make data structures more transparent. ii. Increase data literacy: Understand workflows and data sources so all stakeholders understand the source and meaning of data. Ensure consistency of data standards so aggregated data are from the same context. For example, does the data in a field contain all instances of that data element (e.g. all patients versus only active patients; all visits versus only UDS visits). Maximize the use of data:
