Women, Infants, & Children Program (WIC)

WIC provides nutrition education, access to healthy food, breastfeeding support, and connections to other necessary resources for low-income pregnant people, mothers who had a recent birth, and families with children up to 5 years of age. Food Markets - Napa County
